TASK 1: Writing (Draft Due Week 7, Final copy Week 8, Term 3)

Create a FACT SHEET on an animal - either domesticated or wild. The fact sheet should include a title, information presented in either in short paragraphs or dot points and relevant pictures. Use A-3 sheet of paper.

Information to include:

- Where it is situated / located eg Si trova in Asia
- Mention the physical appearance (remembering placement and agreement of adjectives)
 eg È una giraffa alta con due zampe
- Use prepositions and adverbs
 eg con il collo molto lungo;
- personality of the animal
 eg La giraffa è docile e elegante
- Mention what they eat and drink
 Eg La giraffa mangia le foglie e beve l'acqua
- Extra information
 Eg è erbivere/ selvatico / uccello / qualche volta corre/

Helpful hints to improve your writing skills

- plan your ideas in a logical order
- use the correct format for a Fact Sheet
- ensure accurate spelling, correct punctuation and simple conjunctions to produce a cohesive text
- correct grammatical structures e.g. subject, tense (present) noun and adjective agreement
- use your dictionary to check spelling and words/phrases
- try to think/plan in Italian rather than thinking in English and then translating into Italian
- Do not use GOOGLE TRANSLATE

TASK 2: Speaking (due Week 9, Term 3)

- provide information clearly, loudly and with expression
- speak fluently
- use gestures like an Italian!
