TASK 1: Writing (Draft - due Week 7, Final copy - due Week 8 - Term 1)

Describe your whole ide al house including the garden and give extra information to describe your bedroom in detail. Present your description with a picture of your house and/or pictures of some of the rooms of your incredible house. Make it sound amazing!

Some things to remember:

- Include adjectives (remembering placement and agreement)
 eg È una casa grande e comoda
- Mention the good aspects of where the house is situated eg In centro, vicino al mare, in campagna, vista panoramica
- Use prepositions to describe where rooms are within the house
 eg La cucina è davanti alla sala da pranzo; il bagno è a sinistra
- Mention the outside area
 eg C'è un giardino con piscina, c'è un balcone con vista mare, c'è un garage grandissimo

Helpful hints to improve your writing skills

- Plan your ideas in a logical order
- Use appropriate vocabulary and sentence structures
- Use your dictionary to check spelling and words/phrases
- Ensure accurate spelling, correct punctuation and simple conjunctions to produce a cohesive text
- Correct grammatical structures e.g. subject, tense (present) noun and adjective agreement
- Try to think/plan in Italian rather than thinking in English and then translating into Italian
- Do not use GOOGLE TRANSLATE
