President Elect/ Babel Editor/ Information Officer/ Treasurer**

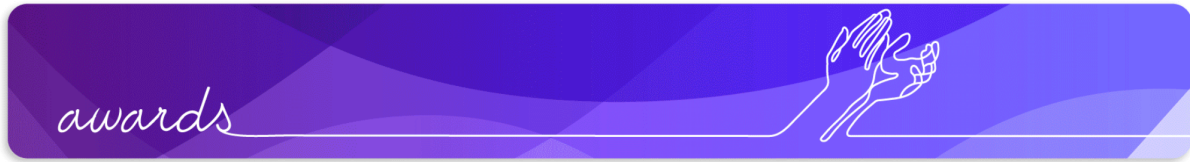
The AFMLTA Executive Committee role holders are volunteers elected at the National Assembly of states and territories in July each year.
